Pro-Karate Academy is affiliated to the English Karate Federation, which is the only English governing body for Karate affiliated to the British Karate Federation and in turn a member of the World Karate Federation, recognised by the International Olympic Committee.

Pro-Karate Academy, formed by Sensei Chelsea, has many classes throughout the Essex and Hertfordshire area, including numerous breakfast and afterschool clubs. All Pro-Karate Academy instructors have a fully enhanced DBS and have full instructors insurance. The style of Karate taught at Pro-Karate Academy is Wado-Ryu, one of the main styles of Japanese Karate founded by Sensei Hironi Otsuka in 1934.

Since Pro-Karate Academy began it has grown and gained much competitive success. Pro-Karate Academy has produced and developed numerous English and British National champions who have gone on to represent England at European and World level.

Dojo Rules and Etiquette

- 1. Always bow when entering and leaving the dojo.
- 2. Clean white Karate GI must be worn.
- 3. Badge must be worn on the left side of the GI.
- 4. No watches, rings, earrings, chains, necklaces, bracelets may be worn.
- 5. Fingers and toenails must be kept short and clean at all times; hands and feet must always be kept clean.
- 6. Long hair must be tied up.
- 7. In the dojo silence must be maintained; no chatting, no smoking, no gum chewing, no eating.
- 8. Instructor should be addressed as 'sensei' and treated with upmost respect.
- 9. Punctuality at all times is essential.
- 10. Bad language must never be used in the dojo or talking negatively about another student.

Payment Scheme

Lesson fees are based on a 48-week year that is then discounted and divided into 12 monthly payments. Students gain one month of free training a year as some months are longer, therefore this is taken into account when students can't attend classes due to Bank Holidays, Christmas holidays, etc.

Fees are to be paid electronically via standing order/monthly subscription.

If you miss any lessons monthly fees are still due.

There is no contract to sign and students can stop attending at anytime however I ask that one months notice and appropriate payment is given if you choose to stop attending PKA classes.

Fees are due the 1st of each calendar month (pro rata).

3. Pro-Karate Licence

- Within your first month of joining ensure you have purchased your child's license book. Your license book provides your affiliation to Pro-Karate Academy and the English Karate Federation (EKF), the only governing body of Karate in England recognised by the IOC Olympic Committee.
- Your license book is also required for gradings. With every new belt your child grades for, you must hand in your license book so that the Sensei marking them can sign and date and update their book with their new belt achievement.
 This is an annual fee that needs to be updated every year.

4. Starter Packs

- Lastly for our gradings just like school exams you must be in the correct uniform. Therefore, before your child's first grading you will need to purchase a starter pack.
